The Future City® Competition is a hands-on, real-world learning experience for middle school students to learn how engineers shape the world we live in today and tomorrow.

Starting in September, students work as a team with an educator and engineer mentor to:

- Design cities using SimCity™ software;
- Research and write solutions to an engineering problem;
- Build tabletop-scale models with recycled materials; and
- Present their ideas before judges at the Regional Competition in January.

The winner of the regional competition travels to Washington, DC for the National Finals in February.

To introduce more students to the program and to help educators get started, particularly those new to the program, the Philadelphia Region Steering Committee is hosting an Engineering Fair, where there will be:

- Engineering activities sponsored by local engineering firms, technical societies, and universities
- Resources for the research essay
- Demonstrations of various ways to develop the required moving part for your model
- Models from previous years
